## **Cornwall Hospice Care's Largest Cream Tea Party World Record Attempt**

### **Terms & Conditions**

The record attempt will have a prompt start and finish time. Whilst the tea party starts at 2pm, the record attempt will start at 3pm – please ensure you arrive no later than 2.30pm.

Your ticket entitles you to attend this World Record Attempt afternoon tea party, drink a cup of English breakfast tea and eat at least one scone with jam and clotted cream (jam first of course!).

To beat the record all attendees taking part must drink a cup of English Breakfast tea and eat at least one scone with a portion of jam and clotted cream. If you are unable to eat or drink any of these please do not sign up to take part (unfortunately we must adhere to the rules and regulations of Guinness World Records™) Alternative food and drinks will not be served. Water will be available.

Gluten free scones are permitted, but please specify this on your application. The regular scones are suitable for vegetarians, but we cannot offer an option for vegans, as clotted cream is specified in the Guinness World Records™ rules and no substitute is accepted. Tea may be drunk with or without milk, but English Breakfast Tea is specified in the rules.

The event is open to anyone over the age of 16. If you are the parent or guardian of someone aged 16-18 by signing them up to this event you are giving consent on their behalf.

In order to provide enough scones and tea (and set a new world record) all guests must register for a place by purchasing a ticket ensuring they can attend the event. Tickets will be available to purchase until the 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

Participants will not be permitted to enter without their tickets as these form part of the verification and counting process.

By signing up to this event you are providing your consent to being filmed and photographed and for this content to be used (at no cost) by the Guinness Book of Records, Cornwall Hospice Care and it's partners (e.g. Royal Cornwall Showground, Cornwall Channel, Your Partnerships and Officially Made in Cornwall).
