Terms and conditions of entry – Coast to Coast

TERMS & CONDITIONS

All walkers should understand that by entering the Coast to Coast they will be agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

- Walkers will complete part of their walk(s) on the open road and when doing so must always abide by the Highway Code.
- All participants under the age of sixteen must be accompanied by a parent/guardian during their participation in this event.
- Walkers participate in this event entirely at their own risk and must rely on their own ability in dealing with all hazards and must participate in a manner which is safe to themselves and others.
- No alcohol is to be consumed prior to or during the event.
- No liability whatsoever shall attach to Cornwall Hospice Care the promoting club/organisation in respect of any injury, loss or damage suffered by walkers in or by reason of the event, unless such injury, loss or damage is proven to be caused by the negligence of the aforementioned. If walkers do not abide by these terms and conditions the organisers will make all reasonable efforts to remove them from the event, and Cornwall Hospice Care will use all efforts to restrict participation in future events of their ownership.
- By entering the Coast to Coast, you agree to your name and any photographs, which may be taken of you or shared to our social media channels, being used by Cornwall Hospice Care.
- To complete the event all walkers must complete the Saint's Way route and may do so in one sitting or across multiple days. Walkers are responsible for their own transport to and from the route.
- Walkers must participate with the following items: A water resistant jacket, refreshments suitable to their own needs, a copy of the route, and a fully charged mobile phone.

- Walkers must follow current Government advice at the time of participation in reference to social distancing and measure to protect against the spread of coronavirus.

REFUND POLICY
