Terms and conditions of entry – Virtually London

TERMS & CONDITIONS

All runners should understand that by entering the Virtually London they will be agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

- Runners may complete part of their run on the open road and when doing so must always abide by the Highway Code.
- Entry is open to those sixteen years or older.
- Runners participate in this event entirely at their own risk and must rely on their own ability in dealing with all hazards and must participate in a manner which is safe to themselves and others.
- No alcohol is to be consumed prior to or during the event.
- No liability whatsoever shall attach to Cornwall Hospice Care the promoting club/organisation in respect of any injury, loss or damage suffered by runners in or by reason of the event, unless such injury, loss or damage is proven to be caused by the negligence of the aforementioned. If runners do not abide by these terms and conditions the organisers will make all reasonable efforts to remove them from the event, and Cornwall Hospice Care will use all efforts to restrict participation in future events of their ownership.
- By entering the Virtually London, you agree to your name and any photographs, which may be taken of you or shared to our social media channels, being used by Cornwall Hospice Care.
- To complete the event all runners must complete the 26.2 Miles and do so on the 4th October 2020, in any number of runs or locations within the 24 hour period to hit the distance target. Runners are responsible for their own transport to and from their routes.
- Runners must participate with the following items: A water resistant jacket if rain is forecast, refreshments suitable to their own needs (water as a minimum) and a fully charged mobile phone or tracking device, such as a Garmin.
- Runners must follow current Government advice at the time of participation in reference to social distancing and measures to protect against the spread of coronavirus.

REFUND POLICY

Registrations are strictly personal; firm and binding and fees shall not be refunded for any reason.
